SUMMARY

1. Non-refundable £275 registration/exam fee to be sent with application (except for Foundation Courses). This fee is a one-off payment and not per exam. If you are taking multiple exams it is only paid once.
2. Payments for courses should be paid once invoice is received (places on the course are limited and will be on a first pay first accepted basis).
3. University fees – an invoice will be issued to applicants who have passed the exam containing details of how to pay and when fees should be paid.

REFUNDS

- The registration/exam fee is non-refundable once paid.
- Once the revision course is booked then the place is taken on the course. There are NO refunds for cancellation of the course.
- All university deposits to secure the place on the course are non-refundable if the place is later turned down
- If the student enrolls but later drops out, then no refund of fees will be made.
